

ANNUAL HUNGER REPORT 2011

DOMESTIC HUNGER FUNDS

- In 2011, Southern Baptist hunger ministries fed more than **5 million** meals to the hungry in **North America**.
- More than **30,000 professions of faith** were reported in 2011 as a result of these hunger relief ministries.
- The cost of a meal at a Southern Baptist hunger ministry averages **30 cents per meal**.

Southern Baptist hunger ministries across North America continue facing an increased number of requests for food.

- Pray for those who minister among the hungry.
- Learn about Southern Baptist hunger ministries in your area and partner with them.
- Involve your family and neighbors in hunger ministry activities.
- Promote giving in your church to benefit hunger relief.

STATE STATISTICS NORTH AMERICAN HUNGER MINISTRIES

- More than 99,000 volunteers helped at 1,100 hunger ministry sites throughout the U.S. in 2011.
- More than \$1 million was distributed by NAMB to Southern Baptist Convention state partners.

World Hunger offerings are disbursed **80 percent** to the International Mission Board for hunger overseas, and **20 percent** to the North American Mission Board for domestic hunger unless otherwise specified.



EVANGELISM STATISTICS NORTH AMERICAN HUNGER MINISTRIES

- 11,000 new hunger ministry volunteers were trained in evangelism in 2011.
- There were over 30,000 professions of faith and 4,201 baptisms reported because of the missionaries and volunteers who shared the gospel through hunger relief.
